Know Your Limits Turkey Shoot

The KYL Turkey Shoot contest will start at 8:00 am November 10th with a safety meeting followed by course of fire shooting instructions. A drawing will be held to determine which relay contestants will be competing in. Bench rest or prone position may be used. No rifles with a bore greater than 30 caliber may be used. **All MSC RULES SHALL APPLY. ALL RIFLES SHALL HAVE EMPTY CHAMBER FLAGS.** Range officers and match director will make final decision if disputes arise. Tie break = most impacts at longest range.

The match official meeting spot is the covered 1000 yard firing line.

Each relay will have a max of 6 shooters on the firing line. (5 relays x 6 shooters=30 max contestants) Shooting order will be determined by a drawing. "A" relay will shoot first; "B" relay will shoot second and so forth.

A one minute period for sight in shots is open to the contestant who is currently up to shoot for score at 600,800 or 1000 (sight in targets only) before they begin shooting for score. It may be best to have spotter observe your hits and misses when sighting in and competing.

Ø When shooting, wait for command from Range Officer before firing your sight in shots or TIMED STRING. Shooters shooting out of turn will be penalized the shot. There will be 5 shots for score at each distance; shooters will have 2.5 minutes to shoot a 5 shot timed string.

When engaging the 1200 yard targets,3 shooters will be on the firing line simultaneously (3 banks of 5 turkeys' ea.) Sight in at 1200 yards will be a 2 minute period open to all 3 shooters simultaneously. 5 shot string for score in 2.5 minutes. Hit to move, left to right.

Two rifles may be used in this contest; (i.e. 6mm Dasher at 600 yards, 7 SAUM at 1200 yards.) etc. etc. etc.

- The 600 yard targets (KYL Rack) count as 6, 8, 10, 12, 14 points per impact for the 6 in., 5 in., 4 in., 3 in., and 2 in. disks respectively; in addition to a 5 point bonus if the rack is cleaned. Starting at 6 in. disk you must hit to move to the next in sequence target.
- The 800 yard targets (8 inch Circular Plate) count as 8 points per impact.
- The 1000 yard targets (10 Circular inch plate) count as 10 points per impact.
- The 1200 yard targets (full size NRA TURKEY silhouette; 23"Hx19"W) count as 15 points each. The target must fall off the rail when hit in order to claim points.
- Total points available are 220. (20 shots for score; 5 at each distance)

Entry fee is \$20 per shooter if a club member; \$30 for nonmembers. \$10 from each entry fee collected will be the prize money pot. Paid out to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place finishers; 50%, 30% and 20% respectively. Medals awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place finishers. In an attempt to expedite contest only 30 contestants will be accepted.

Empty chamber flags shall be used when transporting rifles to firing line and when anyone is down range. (For sale at match. \$3 ea.)
Safety is priority number one. Anyone can give CEASE FIRE command!
Safety is also the second most important thing at this event. Only a Range Officer or Match Director can give COMMENCE FIRING command.
The third most important item on the check list is having a safe, fun day.
Bring water, snacks and a good attitude.

ALL MSC rules apply.

Access point at 500 meter range will be barricaded with Danger–No trespassing safety tape.

Safety rules and course instructions will be discussed and understood before beginning contest.

Every relay will shoot at 600 yard, 800 yard and the 1000 yard targets, before the 1200 yard targets are engaged.

Contest date is November 10th, 2024, starting at 8:00am.
